The Sanctity of Human Life Message Goes to India

This past October I had the opportunity to go on a two week Mission Trip to Southern India. There were eight people from America who went, including me, and two men from India who were also a part of the Mission Team. In Mysore, our first stop, we spoke at a Pastor's Conference, and I spoke the second day on the Sanctity of Human Life. We also did a lot of street witnessing in Mysore, and one of the men from the Mission Team had the opportunity to witness to a Muslim man who was very open to the Gospel.

Our next stop was at a Bible Training Center in Gundlupet that trains pastors in India. Right now they also have eight orphans living there that we had the opportunity to minister to. Next we headed to Gudalur where we ministered at another orphanage and also did some street witnessing.

The last two places we

stopped at were Palamaner and Nellore. We attended a baptism, the dedication of a new church, the dedication of a house for widows, did some more street witnessing, and ministered at several churches. At the last church a couple Team members spoke, and I shared my testimony, and a little bit about Choose Life Ministries. After the service one young lady accepted Christ as her Savior.

One of things that really challenged me while on this Mission Trip was the dedication of the Muslim people. About four or five times every single day there is a Muslim call for prayer. During that call for prayer, which lasts about an hour, everything else that is going on at the time stops. All the shops and everything else close down and all the Muslim men go to the nearest Muslim Mosque to pray. They do this every single day, yet most of us Christians here in America are "too busy" to even

spend ten minutes in prayer each day. If we were as dedicated to our God, who is the one true God, as the Muslims are to their god what great things would we see God do in America?
