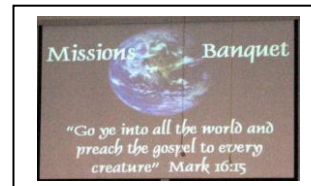
God's Word, Prayer, Activity

It was exciting to have the opportunity to travel south and speak to Sugarloaf B/C on Sugarloaf Key, just 20 miles shy of the southernmost tip of the United States. The public high school there had a pro-life club that met in the school. Our travels then continued on up the East coast of Florida, with our last stop being in Live Oak. We never had to worry about housing, and even most of our meals, as God supplied those needs through His people all across Fl. We headed to Myrtle Beach, SC and encountered thousands of motor cyclists as it was bike week. There were many ministries in the area sharing the gospel, and we hope our van and trailer were also a witness as we traveled down the major thoroughfare. Many of the bikers did give a "thumbs up" sign, and some commented on our signs and bumper stickers, especially at the State Park.

We spent three months in Florida this trip and spoke to 2,865 adults, youth and children at 31 churches and 5 schools. We praise the Lord for every opportunity He has given us to share and ask you to pray that God would continue to open up more and more doors of opportunity to reach as many as possible with the TRUTH.



We finished up the month of May in Virginia Beach, coming into town the day after the Franklin Graham Crusade. We were here just a year ago, and really felt a spirit of revival. On April 29th of this year thousands of Christians had gathered on the beach. United they repented of the sins of our forefathers, our country, and ourselves.

I was born Dec. 3, 1946 to an unwed mother. Though she wanted to raise me, it became obvious to her that, she was not able to do so and I was placed in an orphanage. I was adopted by a wonderful family when I was 4 yrs old and grew up in that home as any biological child would, never knowing anything about my biological family. I accepted Jesus as Lord and Savior, July 21, 1971 and surrendered to the ministry.

I began to have an interest in finding something about my biological family when I was 59 years old, since

both adoptive parents and one of my adopted sisters were now deceased. I began tracing down my family, and I found that my birth mother had died in 2001 but that I had other siblings. Through research on the internet, we discovered that I had a biological brother living in Toledo, Ohio and contact was made. On May 10, 2007 I met my brother for the first time in my 60 years of life, what an overwhelming experience. God is so good. I not only was adopted twice, but I now have three families, **one adopted physically, one adopted spiritually and one by birth.**

The main point of the Sanctity of Human Life message is that we are created in the image of God and that is where our value comes from. This message is especially important to teach our children as they are bombarded with the lie of evolution through museums and tv programs. God has shown us our need to emphasize the truths of Genesis as we share the SOHL and gospel message with them. The Continuing Pro-Life Battle

Every day in the news it seems we are hearing about abortion. Whether it's the controversy surrounding the partial birth abortion ban or embryonic stem cell research or the morning after pill. As I found out today, what seems to be good news, in reality is another deceitful tactic by those who are anti-life.

Apparently, closer scrutiny of the ruling on the partial birth abortion ban has revealed that a doctor can deliver the baby to the navel instead of the base of the skull, and then proceed to take the baby's life. Then, just this week the FDA removed the requirement for a

prescription for the morning after pill, and finally, although adult stem cells have been found to cure even diabetes, there is a still a push for embryonic stem cell research. In each in every case a human life is destroyed. "Our message is simple - but firm: ALL HUMAN LIFE IS SACRED. The absolute *right to life* far outweighs any other rights or freedoms of debate. End of discussion". (Jay Sekelow, in response to the freedom of choice act.) There is some good news. The PBA ban has set a

precedent and has spurred many states to enact stricter abortion laws. Women who are strongly pro-choice can no longer deny that a human life is being snuffed out as this quote shows from a woman undergoing a "reduction" abortion after in vitro fertilization. "It's killing me that we're going to do this. I never thought I would feel that... I'm vehemently pro-choice." Yet the sight of seeing the needle, as one nurse puts it, "chasing the babies" who try to get away, overwhelms mothers". It should overwhelm us all.
