First is the story of Diana and her baby boy Isaac. During a prenatal doctor's appointment, Diana was asked 4 times if she would consider abortion. Why? Her first child who is four years old is autistic and they feared that baby Isaac might also develop autism. Then they said the baby could have down's syndrome. Diana had resolved to choose life regardless of the possibilities. The value of Isaac's life is not based on his abilities or what

he will someday become, but on the fact that he is a masterpiece fashioned by the Creator. Diana wanted her story shared so that other woman facing pressure from their doctors could be encouraged to Choose Life for their baby. God is the giver of all life and He alone knows the outcome.

The second story is about a family who chose to adopt when they were unable to have children of their own. In Ocala, we met the pastor of FBC of Summerfield, Dr. Hunkus, and his wife Candy who have adopted 5 children. In each case the parents were unable to care properly for their children and gave them
