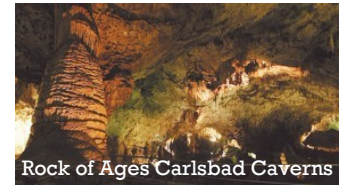

On November 7, South Dakotans will go to the polls to vote on Referred Law 6, a bill that, if passed, will ban all surgical and medical

abortions in their state. **This law has tremendous national and international implications.** For instance, this law may work to challenge and possibly overturn *Roe v Wade* and *Doe v Bolton*, the US Supreme Court decisions that decriminalized abortion in our country. A victory will embolden pro-lifers and pro-life politicians in other states to enact similar laws in their own state. Finally, it will embolden pro-lifers all across the globe to defend attacks from the international abortion lobby that are attempting to decriminalize abortion in their

own lands.

One of the needs in the churches we traveled to out west is to have an active youth ministry. I was able to give the presentation to 9 youth groups, and a total of around 165 youth. One of the greatest ministry opportunities was in the Slaton/Lubbock, Texas

area. This area of Texas has the highest teen pregnancy and STD rate in the nation. 3 youth groups came to West view B/C to hear the message, and one young couple with 3 small children were especially encouraged. The most encouraging and fun youth

group we got to meet and speak to was at The Fellowship in Lubbock. They planned an all day event just to spend time with the MK's. We enjoyed the fellowship and the services, and ONE YOUTH WAS SAVED!

We began our trip out west on July 21, 2006. We have traveled to Missouri, Kansas, Colorado, New Mexico, Texas, and Oklahoma. Our last stop will be in Western, Kentucky. So far we have had the opportunity to speak to the children at 18 out of 22 of the churches we've been to. In all, we have spoken to approximately 150 children.

At our first stop in Pierce City, Missouri, 2 girls were saved!

One of the opportunities that we wanted to mention was in Lubbock, Texas. While there, we presented our program at an apartment complex to the children who lived there. We did everything outside in the courtyard.

Even the adults living there heard the message! Dad spoke to 39 adults at their bible study as well.
