He has given us the opportunity to counsel with those who have been wounded by abortion, as well as with those who had no hope and had given up on life. We also had the privilege of sharing with a mom who had went through the struggle of her teen daughter's pregnancy, and we shared in praising the Lord together for how He had moved in that situation to save a baby's life. Her awesome testimony included how she heard the baby crying from the womb and how God worked out the adoption into a wonderful family for this precious child. It reminds us how we are adopted into the family of God because of the sacrifice of our Lord and savior Jesus Christ. We want that mom to know we thank God for her and her choice of LIFE and for her sacrifice.

Update on Jennifer. We met Jennifer in June of 2005. She is a precious little girl. She was born with Down Syndrome and a hole in her heart. She had many challenges facing her and her family. The doctors never gave much hope that she would ever be able to perform the basics of life, but praise God she is now feeding herself and is able to do much more than they had hoped or dreamed.

I started feeling the call to speak to youth groups in January of 2005 on "Sanctity of Human Life" Sunday. I spoke to my first youth group at First Baptist church, in Dewitt, Ky. I had my home youth group come with me for support. I never felt comfortable speaking in front of people. It was a really different experience for me, but it was fun and I was ready to do it again. God's Holy Spirit had empowered and enabled me. I didn't speak to another youth group after that until June, when our family started going to Ohio to speak at different churches. In Ohio,

Virginia, and Kentucky, and Florida, God opened up several opportunities for me to share the truth about abortion. Since June of 2005 I have spoken at 16 youth groups, with anywhere from four to 60 youth in each church. Every Youth group is a different experience, some good, some not so good, but overall it has been a good experience, and it's been exciting to see God move in the hearts of youth. Everywhere I've gone there's been at least one person who either responded to the message or was encouraged by the message.

Jonah's life is unique and special and though he faces many challenges every day, Jonah is such a wonderful blessing to his family and those who have had the privilege of meeting him.
